## Windows & Linux

### Tab & window shortcuts

Action	Shortcut
Open a new window	<b>Ctrl + n</b>
Open a new window in Incognito mode	<b>Ctrl + Shift + n</b>
Open a new tab, and jump to it	<b>Ctrl + t</b>
Reopen previously closed tabs in the order they were closed	<b>Ctrl + Shift + t</b>
Jump to the next open tab	<b>Ctrl + Tab</b> or <b>Ctrl + PgDn</b>
Jump to the previous open tab	<b>Ctrl + Shift + Tab</b> or <b>Ctrl + PgUp</b>
Jump to a specific tab	<b>Ctrl + 1</b> through <b>Ctrl + 8</b>
Jump to the rightmost tab	<b>Ctrl + 9</b>
Open your home page in the current tab	<b>Alt + Home</b>
Open the previous page from your browsing history in the current tab	<b>Alt + Left arrow</b>
Open the next page from your browsing history in the current tab	<b>Alt + Right arrow</b>
Close the current tab	<b>Ctrl + w</b> or <b>Ctrl + F4</b>
Close the current window	<b>Ctrl + Shift + w</b> or <b>Alt + F4</b>
Minimize the current window	<b>Alt + Space</b> then <b>n</b>
Maximize the current window	<b>Alt + Space</b> then <b>x</b>
Quit Google Chrome	<b>Alt + f</b> then <b>x</b>
Move tabs right or left	<b>Ctrl + Shift + PgUp</b> or <b>Ctrl + Shift + PgDn</b>

Action	Shortcut
Open options to print the current page	<b>Ctrl + p</b>
Open options to save the current page	<b>Ctrl + s</b>
Reload the current page	<b>F5</b> or <b>Ctrl + r</b>
Reload the current page, ignoring cached content	<b>Shift + F5</b> or <b>Ctrl + Shift + r</b>
Stop the page loading	<b>Esc</b>
Browse clickable items moving forward	<b>Tab</b>
Browse clickable items moving backward	<b>Shift + Tab</b>

Open a file from your computer in Chrome	<b>Ctrl + o</b> + Select a file
Display non-editable HTML source code for the current page	<b>Ctrl + u</b>
Save your current webpage as a bookmark	<b>Ctrl + d</b>
Save all open tabs as bookmarks in a new folder	<b>Ctrl + Shift + d</b>
Turn full-screen mode on or off	<b>F11</b>
Make everything on the page bigger	<b>Ctrl and +</b>
Make everything on the page smaller	<b>Ctrl and -</b>
Return everything on the page to default size	<b>Ctrl + 0</b>
Scroll down a webpage, a screen at a time	<b>Space</b> or <b>PgDn</b>
Scroll up a webpage, a screen at a time	<b>Shift + Space</b> or <b>PgUp</b>
Go to the top of the page	<b>Home</b>
Go to the bottom of the page	<b>End</b>
Scroll horizontally on the page	<b>Shift + Scroll</b> your mousewheel
Move your cursor to the beginning of the previous word in a text field	<b>Ctrl + Left arrow</b>
Move your cursor to the next word	<b>Ctrl + Right arrow</b>
Delete the previous word in a text field	<b>Ctrl + Backspace</b>
Open the Home page in the current tab	<b>Alt + Home</b>

## Mouse shortcuts

## Mac

If you're on Mac Catalina and up, keyboard navigation is turned on by default in your system preferences.

**Tip:** To focus your keyboard on text boxes or list items, press **⌘ + F7**.

Action	Shortcut
Open a new window	<b>⌘ + n</b>
Open a new window in Incognito mode	<b>⌘ + Shift + n</b>
Open a new tab, and jump to it	<b>⌘ + t</b>
Reopen previously closed tabs in the order they were closed	<b>⌘ + Shift + t</b>
Jump to the next open tab	<b>⌘ + Option + Right arrow</b>
Jump to the previous open tab	<b>⌘ + Option + Left arrow</b>
Jump to a specific tab	<b>⌘ + 1</b> through <b>⌘ + 8</b>
Jump to the last tab	<b>⌘ + 9</b>
Open the previous page in your browsing history for the current tab	<b>⌘ + [</b> or <b>⌘ + Left arrow</b>
Open the next page in your browsing history for the current tab	<b>⌘ + ]</b> or <b>⌘ + Right arrow</b>
Close the current tab or pop-up	<b>⌘ + w</b>
Close the current window	<b>⌘ + Shift + w</b>
Minimize the window	<b>⌘ + m</b>
Hide Google Chrome	<b>⌘ + h</b>
Quit Google Chrome	<b>⌘ + q</b>

**Ctrl + Shift + PgUp** or **Ctrl + Shift + PgDn**

Compose a new email message with a link to the current page	<b>⌘ + Shift + i</b>
Open options to print the current page	<b>⌘ + p</b>

Open the Page Setup dialog	<b>⌘ + Option + p</b>
Reload your current page, ignoring cached content	<b>⌘ + Shift + r</b>
Stop the page loading	<b>Esc</b>
Browse clickable items moving forward	<b>Tab</b>
Browse clickable items moving backward	<b>Shift + Tab</b>
Open a file from your computer in Google Chrome	<b>⌘ + o</b> + Select a file

Make everything on the page smaller	<b>⌘ and -</b>
Return everything on the page to the default size	<b>⌘ + 0</b>
Scroll down a webpage, a screen at a time	<b>Space</b>
Scroll up a webpage, a screen at a time	<b>Shift + Space</b>
Search the web	<b>⌘ + Option + f</b>
Move your cursor to the beginning of the previous word in a text field	<b>Option + Left arrow</b>
Move your cursor to the back of the next word in a text field	<b>Option + Right arrow</b>
Delete the previous word in a text field	<b>Option + Delete</b>
Open your home page in the current tab	<b>⌘ + Shift + h</b>
